




Dear Parents and Carers,

<u>Phonics</u> This term we will continue our Little Wandle Phase 1 activities which provides the children with a firm foundation for phonics, ready for Reception (Activities include listening to and making sounds, rhyming words, alliteration in our 'silly soups' and segmenting & blending) This term, we'll also 'squiggle while we wiggle', to our

favourite pop songs as well as 'write' some graphemes (letters) and hold a pen with our 'pecking' fingers. Our aim is to make learning fun and for the children to 'have a go'!
